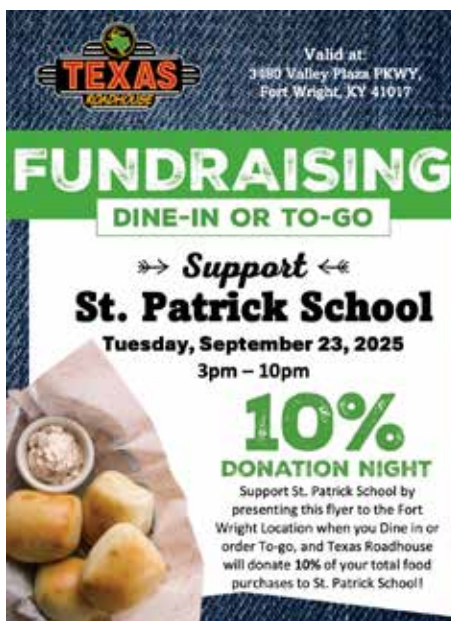

Last year, Texas Roadhouse brought the school \$265 and the Chipotle fundraiser brought \$475 in monies to pay for

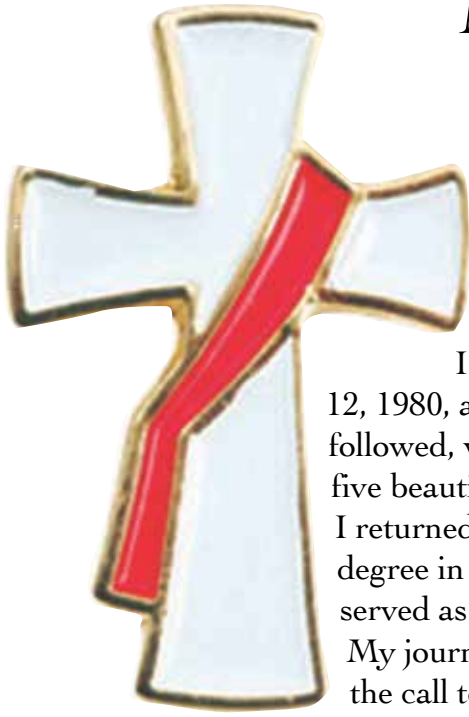

My Journey to St. Patrick Church

I came to Kentucky in 1971 because of something many of you drive over nearly every day. We moved from Pennsylvania so my father could build the I-75/275 interchange in Erlanger. He was the project's chief engineer. I graduated from Dixie in 1977. Went on to work on many projects with my father.

I met my wife, Kim, in 1978, and we got married on September 12, 1980, and have lived in Florence for the last 45 years. Our children followed, with Kristina arriving in 1983 and Kelly in 1986. I now have five beautiful grandchildren, ranging in age from 8 to 16 years old.

I returned to college in 1991 and graduated from TMU in 1994 with a degree in Business and a CMA in accounting. For the next 30 years, I served as the CFO of a union Sheet Metal manufacturer in Cincinnati.

My journey of faith began in 2011, when the Lord placed on my heart the call to enter fully into the Catholic Church. Looking back, I see this moment through the words of Jesus in Matthew 7:7-8: "Ask, and it will be given you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you."

For many years, I had been asking questions, seeking truth, and knocking at doors that never quite opened. But in the Church, I found the fullness of Christ's promise. The sacraments, the teaching, and the community of faith were not just answers to my questions—they were the very presence of God drawing me closer.

As I continued to walk in faith, the Lord kept inviting me deeper. In 2018, through Cursillo and other encounters, I discovered that when we say "yes" to God, He always shows us the next step. In time, He placed upon my heart the call to the diaconate. It was another "door" I had to knock on, not knowing what was on the other side—but trusting that Christ Himself would be the one to open it.

My journey has brought me here—to you, the people of St. Patrick. Just as the Lord once invited me to seek, to knock, and to walk through the doors of the Catholic Church, so now He has opened the door for me to serve you in humility and in love. Here at St. Patrick, I have been blessed to encounter Christ in so many ways: through our school, where the faith is handed on to the youngest disciples; through CCD, where children and families continue to grow in the love of God; and through OCIA, where men and women who, like me years ago, are seeking and knocking, come to find Christ's Church welcoming them home.

In each of these ministries, I am reminded that the diaconate is not about me, but about service. It is about washing feet, lifting hearts, and carrying the love of God into every corner of our parish family. Whether it is standing at the altar, teaching the faith, or simply being present with someone in a moment of need, I pray that I may always serve you with the same generosity with which God has served me.

My calling has taught me that true joy comes not from being recognized, but from quietly bringing the love of God into the lives of others. And so, together with all of you, I look forward to building up this community of faith, rooted in the Gospel, strengthened by the sacraments, and alive in the Spirit of Christ.

HISTORY OF EXALTATION OF THE CROSS (SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 14)

In 326, Constantine's mother, Saint Helena, a devout Christian, embarked on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Her mission was to identify significant sites from Christ's life and establish churches at those locations. In Jerusalem, she aimed to find the True Cross and to build a church over the sites of Mount Calvary and Jesus' tomb, known as the Holy Sepulchre. Upon identifying Mount Calvary and the empty tomb, she discovered three discarded and buried crosses. After an investigation, the local bishop confirmed they were the crosses used to crucify Jesus and the two thieves. Since Helena did not know which cross was Christ's, she arranged for a sick woman to touch all three. The woman was immediately healed upon touching one of them, indicating that it was the True Cross.

Although we commemorate these three historical events today, the core of our celebration is not the physical wood of the Cross or the holy sites where Jesus died and was buried. Our primary focus is the infinite love shown through the selfless and perfect Sacrifice of the Son of God and the boundless mercy that has poured forth upon the world as a result.

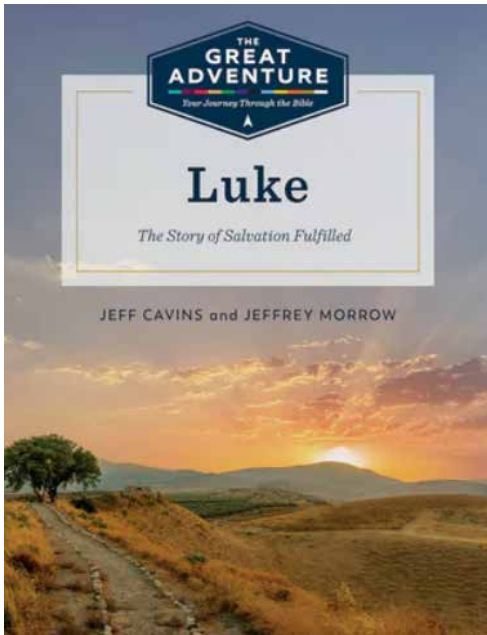

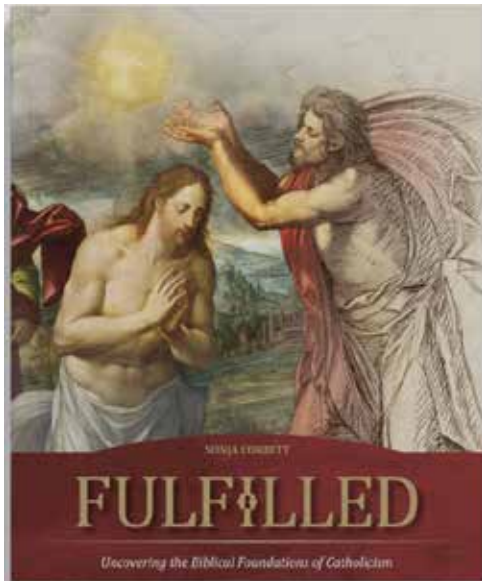
