

#### **PADRE'S PATCH UPDATE**

The garaden is getting off to a great start this year after a lot of hard work by a lot of hard workers. We still have room in one of the raised beds as well as ground space for vegetables. Unfortunately there is an abundance of weeds that need pulling! After a short rainfall the weeds come out easier... it's best if the roots come out with the full weed. The best time to stop in the garden is in the morning and evening when it's not full sun. There are always plenty of gloves at the Patch.

Recent Activity: New additions: Pole bean plants; Beefsteak tomato plants; Cucumbers; Pollinator plants along the fence line; Dill patch (dill pickles in fall); Asparagus plants (next to the kale). Also, we have added soaker hoses on both lanes of tomatoes. Organic approved chemicals are now stored in the large yellow barrel.
